Motion was made by Steve Dolin to approve agenda, seconded by Jim Beck; motion carried with the following addition:

CLERK REPORT

Minutes of the August 2015 regular township board meeting were distributed and reviewed.

Motion was made by Marvin Mathiowetz to approve the August meeting minutes, seconded by Steve Dolin; motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer Martha Skogen presented a written financial report to the Board for review. Income and payments from **Bremer Bank** for the month are as follows:

Motion was made by Marvin Mathiowetz to accept Treasurer's Report, seconded by Jim Beck; motion carried.

ROAD UPDATES

- Gravel Update – All Class 5 that has been stockpiled, has now been spread throughout township.
- Crushing has now started at the Koppendraye Pit.
- Culverts have been installed on 145th Avenue and 155th Avenue South.
- Will be cleaning ditch on 165th Avenue.
- Garbage needs to be picked up on 115 Avenue.
- 2015-16 Snowplowing – Paul will be drawing up an amended contract and bring to next board meeting for review/approval.

Motion was made by Steve Dolin to have contact amended to include additional plowing miles, seconded by Marvin Mathiowetz; motion carried.

- Steve is 2/3 completed on moving township ditches.
- On Labor Day weekend, Jim reported that County had left their machines parked on the edge of Davenport, with no proper marking. Jim called the County to get these machines moved right away, as some resident almost ran into them.

PUBLIC FORUM

- Keith Buisman attended meeting and questioned fencing options available to his property. Scot advised him of the current building codes that need to be followed, fence cannot be on property line – must be 3 feet away.
- Jim Williams is getting different plans for a larger pole barn. When they become available, he will resubmit permit application.

PLANNING & ZONING REPORT

- Scot handed out a draft copy of an ordinance amending the Greenbush Township Zoning Ordinance marked up by Township Attorney. Board will review information and discuss at a later meeting.
- Scot also handed out to the board for review a copy of Ordinance# LSO 2015-02 - Mille Lacs County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 3, "Public Health" an Ordinance amending Article 3, "Subsurface sewage treatment systems.

FIRE REPORT

- 2 Medical Runs in August
- Open House took place at Wyanett, very good turnout.
- Will be a 3-4% increase for fire coverage in 2016.
- Going to raise their service from the Relief Association to \$3,000 a year.

Motion was made by Marvin Mathiowetz to approve Claims List for Approval Report, seconded by Steve Dolin; motion carried.


Motion was made by Steve Dolin to adjourn meeting at 9:07 p.m., seconded by Jim Beck; motion carried.
